Monitoring Plan for Buffer Compliance Tracking

103F.48 Riparian Protection and water Quality Practices

Adopted: September 27<sup>th</sup> 2018

1. The Grant Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) will track buffer compliance every, third year dependent on the availability of aerial imagery that is adequate to ascertain the potential compliance or non-compliance with 103F.48 or on a more frequent basis if new imagery is made available.
2. The Grant SWCD will meet with the Grant County Office of Land Management (OLM), and Legal Ditch Authorities on an annual basis to review non-compliant parcels to update documented compliance and enforcement activities.
3. Tracking on an ongoing basis will be completed by the SWCD, OLM and Grant County ditch authority through a shared access GIS system developed for the purpose of compliance tracking.
4. Complaints relating to buffer non-compliance will be forwarded to the appropriate enforcement authority for final compliance determination and tracked through the shared GIS system.
